Lori Sherman led the meeting speaking about the remainder of Marching Band season. Regionals and State Championship Qualifications were explained. Regionals will be held at Centaurus HS. Check the Colorado Bandmasters Assoc (CBA) website to follow current standings. The band's next competition will be Arapahoe at Littleton HS.

Volunteers: Must be physically able to help with moving pit equipment or props. We appreciate all help, but do not want anyone getting hurt. We are currently short on lunch help. Please check the signupegenius.

State Championships: Quarterfinals, Friday, October 27th - Will be at the Air Force Academy. All drivers must have valid proof of car insurance, registration. The Air Force has the right to check every car/trunk. Please not firearms. If parents are reserving hotel rooms, please let Mr. Evans know that your student is staying with you and not returning on the bus Friday. There is not guarantee that the band will be returning on Saturday to perform in the Semi Finals.

Questions was asked about Regional time. MRHS will perform at 8pm. Mr. Evans will send out an itinerary. Everyone is encouraged to stay and watch the other bands.

Lori discussed how Marching Band is judged by opinions of the judges. This can cause shifts in points between Prelims and Finals.
